

The Great Lakes

 Great Lakes are a chain of interconnected freshwater lakes. They are also known as Laurentian Great Lakes or Great Lakes of North America.
 These lakes are located in the upper mid-east area of North America – basically on Canada's and USA's border.
 The St. Lawrence River connects the Lakes to the Atlantic Ocean.

4. Great Lakes are comprised of : Lake Superior, Lake Erie, Lake Michigan, Lake Huron, and Lake Ontario.

5. The name Lake Superior is derived from the French word "ac supérieur" meaning the upper lake which generally refers to its positioning (north of Huron).

6. Ojibwe (indigenous group in North America) people call Lake Superior as gichi-gami. Gichi means big, large or great and Gami refers to either sea, lake, or water.

7. Lake Erie is named from the Erie tribe. The word from which the name is derived is 'erielhonan' – an Iroquoian word which means Long Tail.

8. Lake Michigan is again derived from the language of Ojibwe people. It is derived from mishi-gami where mishi means great, and gami is water or lake.

9. Lake Huron was named after Wyandot (indigenous group in North America) who were known as Hurons.

10. They called Lake Huron as karegnondi. This lake was given different names by travelers like Freshwater Sea, Lake of the Hurons, or lake.
